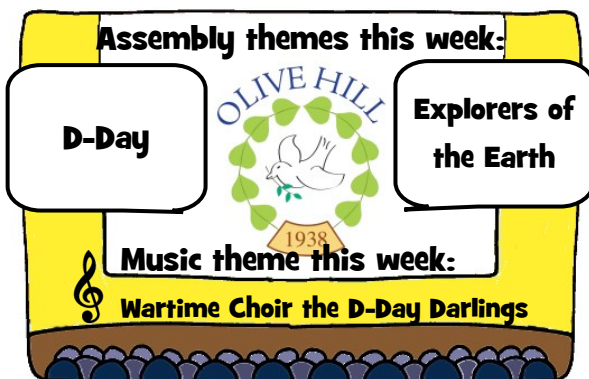
We would like you to give a happy birthday to Mrs White since it was her 30th birthday on Wednesday. Congratulations and we hope you have a great week!
