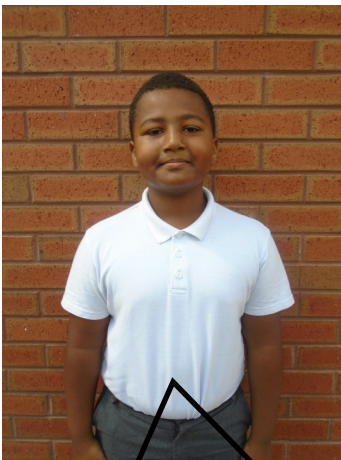
THE VOTES ARE IN!
